Syracuse to Host 2026 IKMF Kettlebell World Championships

Syracuse, NY – Monday, September 29, 2025 – Syracuse, New York, will host the **2026 IKMF Kettlebell World Championships** at **The Oncenter** over **Memorial Day Weekend, May 22–24, 2026**.

The IKMF World Championships is the premier international kettlebell endurance competition, bringing together **over 300 athletes from 35 countries** across every continent. This will be one of the largest international sporting events ever held in Syracuse.

Founded by Stéphane Dauvergne, the **International Kettlebell Marathon Federation (IKMF)** standardizes marathon and pentathlon kettlebell competitions worldwide. The 2026 Championships will feature:

- **Half Marathon** – athletes lift kettlebells up to 70 lbs. continuously for 30 minutes without setting them down
- **KB Games** – men and women lift 88 lb. and 60 lb. kettlebells, respectively
- **Pentathlon** – a multi-discipline test of strength, endurance, and precision

“The IKMF World Championships are not just a test of strength—they are a celebration of resilience, skill, and global unity,” said **Judi DeMuro, USA Representative to the IKMF**. “Syracuse will provide an incredible stage for this international gathering.”
